What is Chatham PASS?

Chatham PASS is a partnership between Chatham County Public Libraries and Chatham County Schools.

It is a program designed to provide all Chatham County Schools students the opportunity to access recreational and educational materials at any Chatham County Public Library (CCPL) branch or through the CCPL website.

Students no longer need a traditional library card to access materials. Instead, they can use their school ID number to access public library services.

The default PIN is the last 4 digits of the student ID.



With their Chatham PASS account, students can:

Borrow up to 10 print or audiobooks at a time.

Borrow digital materials, such as eBooks, eAudiobooks, and magazines.

Information for Parents

All Chatham County Schools students are automatically enrolled in the Chatham PASS program.

If you do not want your child to participate, you may opt out. Contact your child's School Library Media Coordinator to make this request.

There are no overdue fines for Chatham PASS accounts, but students are responsible for fees on lost or damaged items.

Materials borrowed from Chatham County Public Libraries must be returned to a CCPL branch.
