## PBS Implementation – Week 1

Introduce Matrix to your students

The poster could be an individual assignment for one of your teachers within the team (example Language Arts class). However, the matrix should be displayed in each of your classes in English and Spanish.

Refer to this throughout the first week and year when necessary – watch Ron Clark video

Emphasize that this is part of our school-wide expectations in each of our areas of the school. Explain that in order for our school to be a place where learning is fun, safe, and efficient these things have to be in place.

Remember that we don't need to talk about this or introduce it as a reward system because it is not in and of itself.
