Tips for success:

- Be inclusive! Think generic holidays and winter scenes. We want everyone to buy our cards!
- Pay attention to proportions—the cards will be 5 x 7 inches. This means a 10 x 14 image will reduce perfectly, but a 9 x 12 work will lose part of the image from the sides and bottom.
- Have the most important part of the image in the center; don't do a decorative border near the edge because some of it may be lost.
- Work in whatever medium inspires you, BUT don't submit pieces larger than 11 x 17—they will be too large to scan.
- Strong, rich colors with distinct lines will print well. Pencil is too light to make a good printed image.
- Digital art and photography are fine, but the resolution must be high enough for good printing—a minimum of 350 dpi.
