

Bonlee School Athletic Requirements:

1. Athletes will lose privilege of participation on athletic teams for the followings reasons:
 - The accumulations of five (5) strikes in one season/semester or eight (8) for the year.
 - Second Parent Contact: 1 strike
 - In School Suspension (ISS): 2 strikes
 - Out of School Suspension (OSS): 3 strikes
 - If a student/athlete accumulates five (5) strikes in the first semester, he/she will be ineligible for the remainder of that semester/season. (i.e. softball and basketball) If a student/athlete accumulates eight (8) strikes during the course of the year, he/she will lose eligibility for the remainder of the school year.
2. All student/athletes must be picked up within 10 minutes of the conclusion of all practices/games. (may be modified by individual coaches)
 - 1st offense - warning
 - 2nd offense – 1 game suspension
 - 3rd offense – Suspended from Team
3. If a student/athlete receives a strike due to a parent contact on a practice day, the student/athlete may attend practice with the coach deciding game day consequences. If it falls on a game day, the student/athlete may attend the game but will not be allowed to dress out and/or play.
4. If a student/athlete is in ISS or on OSS, the student/athlete may not participate in practices or games that day. This is inexcusable and will result in the student missing a minimum of one game. Student/athletes are considered role models and as such are required to show self-discipline.
5. As a parent, if you have any questions, please handle them in the following manner/order:
 - See the coach of the given team
 - See the athletic director
 - See the principal
6. If you have a complaint, please do not go to the coach before, during, or immediately after the game. Please contact the coach at a later time to request a conference.
7. At all times, the main focus will be teaching and learning. Always encourage good sportsmanship.
