Safety is Our Top Priority

- We offer a competitive staff-to-child ratio, with a senior staff member always on-site and in charge.
- We ask about allergies and special needs on the registration form, and keep that information available at the program site.

Nurturing & Fun YMCA Staff

Pre-K students will have a group just for them with two counselors who are responsible for the children's activities.

- Counselors lead and supervise the kids through a wide variety of activities designed to support meeting developmental milestones.
- YMCA staff members receive 30 hours of training, plus additional evaluation and training throughout employment.
- A senior staff member oversees YMCA counselors and provides senior leadership at each After School program. The site coordinator is the on-site contact for parents, teachers and educators.
