

Cell Phone Violation Policy Overview

Grades 6-12

- First offense: Up to 1 day ISS
- Second offense: Up to 1-day OSS
- Third offense: Up to 3 days OSS

I-5 Wireless communication devices – The Board of Education recognizes that cellular phones and other wireless communication devices have become an important tool through which parents communicate with their children. Therefore, students are permitted to possess such devices on school property so long as the devices are not activated, used, displayed, or visible during the instructional day or as otherwise directed by school rules or school personnel.

** Students can have cell phones out before school, class change, lunch, and after school. Phones cannot be used when students are in the hallway during instructional time (i.e. going to office, testing, bathroom during class period).

Cell Phone Violation (Student Gives Up)

1st Offense: Warning, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
2nd Offense: 1 Day ISS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
3rd Offense: 1 Day OSS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
4th Offense: 3 Days OSS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
5th Offense: Loss of Cell Phone Privileges

Cell Phone Violation (Student Refuses to Give Up When Directly Requested by Faculty/Staff Member)

1st Offense: 1 Day ISS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
2nd Offense: 1 Days OSS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
3rd Offense: 2 Days OSS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
4th Offense: 5 Days OSS, Parent Pick Up at Front Desk
5th Offense: Loss of Cell Phone Privileges
